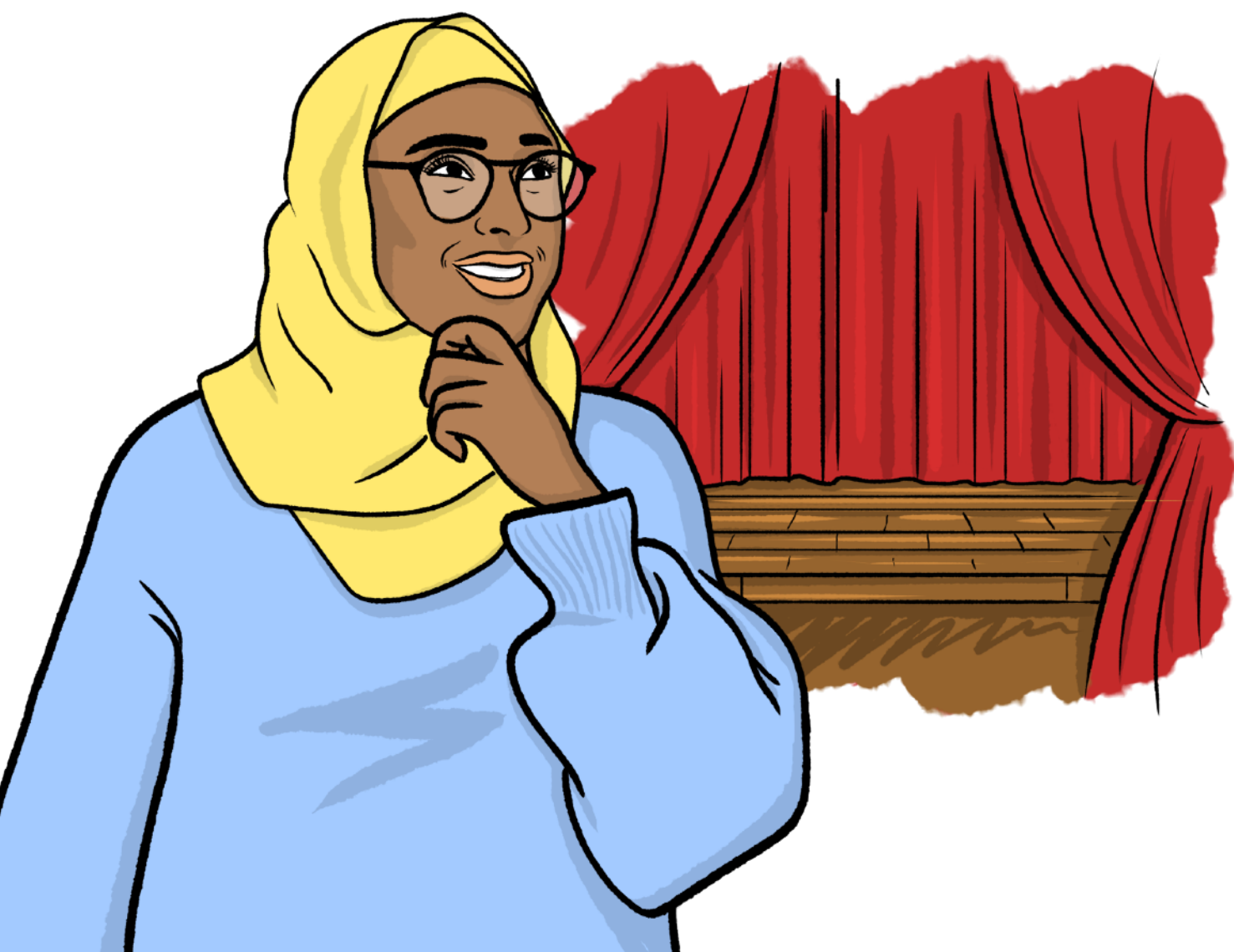

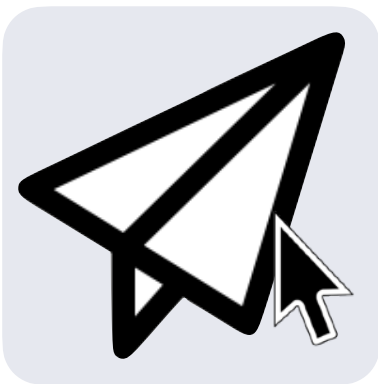

# Introduction



CRIPtic Arts is an organisation that supports **D/deaf**, disabled and **neurodivergent** people who work in **the arts**.



**D/deaf** means the person is either **Deaf** with a capital d, or **deaf** with a small d. The two are different.

**deaf** means someone who finds it hard to hear.

**Deaf** means someone has been unable to hear all their lives and use sign language.



**Neurodivergent** means your brain works in a different way than most people's. You may be autistic or have a mental health condition.



**The arts** are all the different types of art, like theatre, dance and music.



We are looking at what all organisations and projects need to do to include everyone.

We call this 'minimum access standards'.

- What minimum access standards should be.

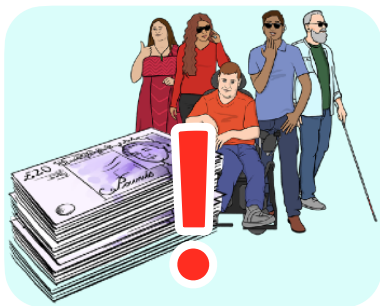

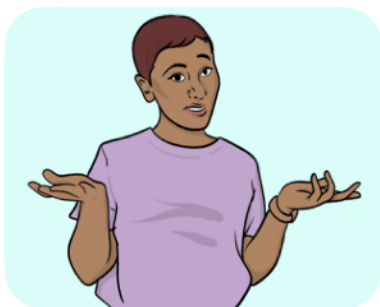

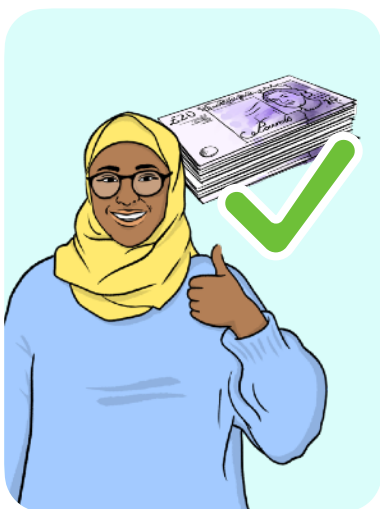
# Different types of organisations

Some organisations may not be able to afford to do everything.



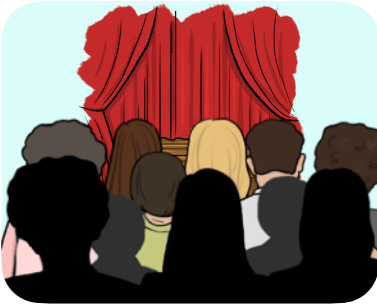

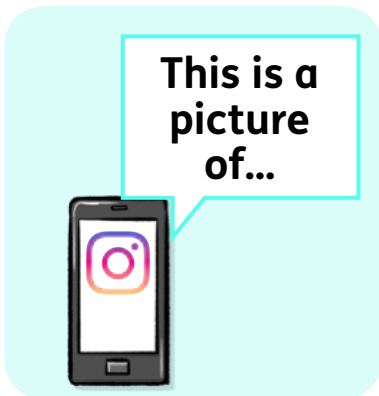
**Alt-text** is words that describe a picture for a screen reader to read out.
